

# Protecting Corals Starts With YOU!

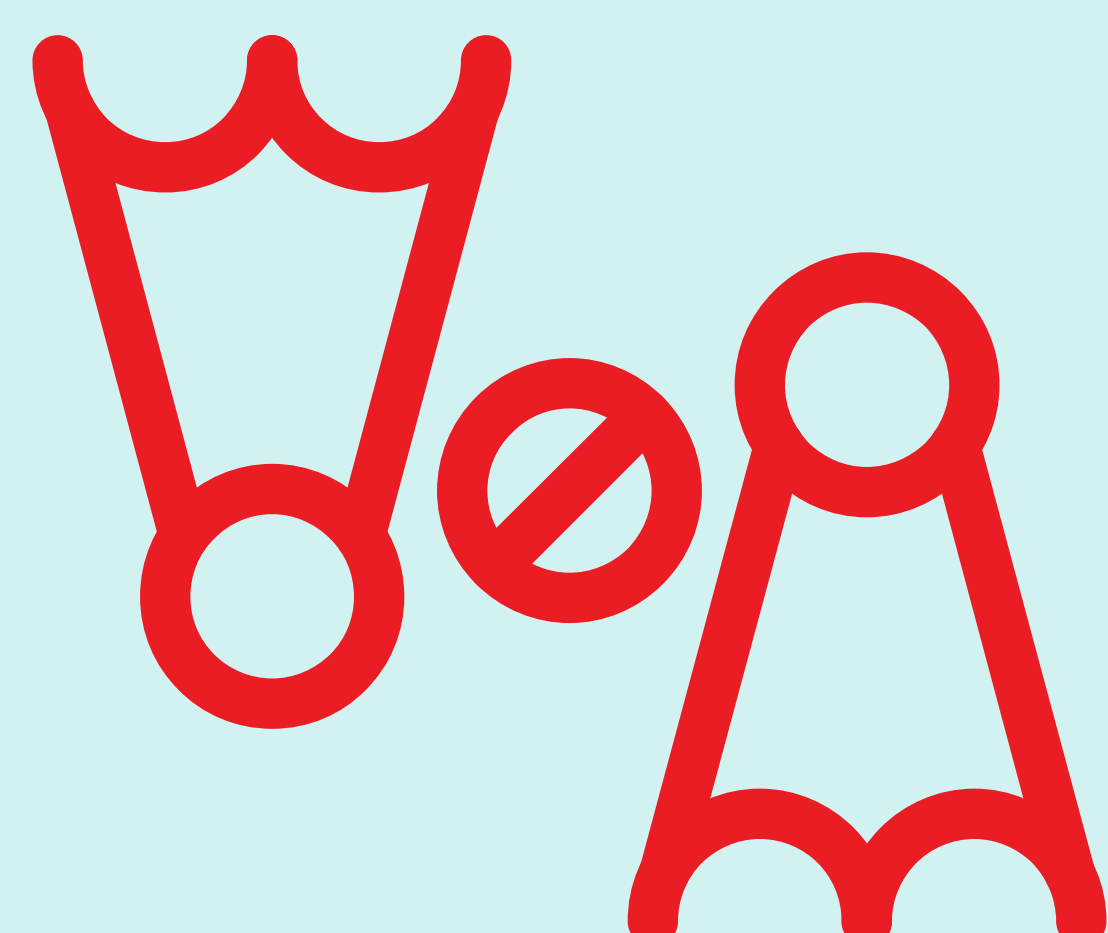


*We LOVE coral and how beautiful it is! Just make sure you enjoy coral areas responsibly by taking a few simple actions during your time in the water and on beach.*

them.



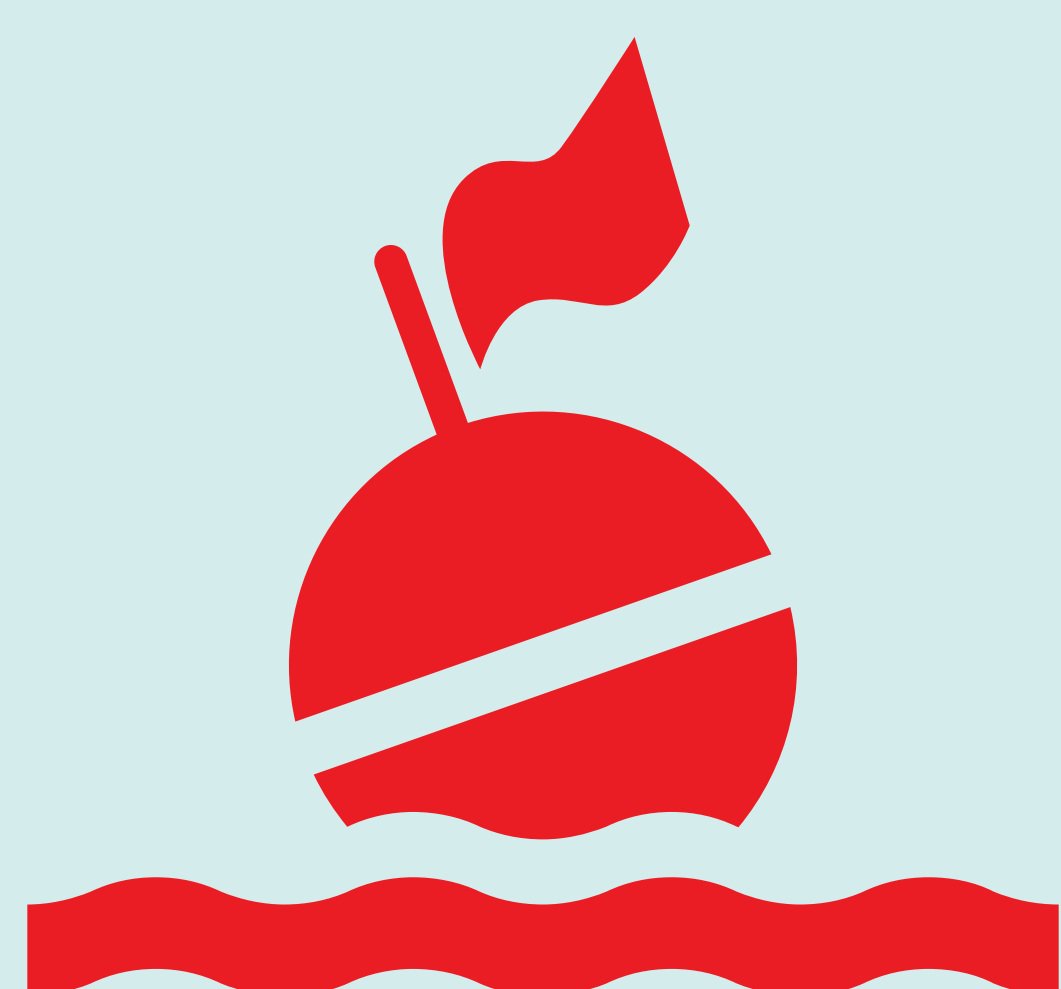
## What Belongs to The Sea Stays in The Sea

## Be a Cautious Boater

Ask about the locations of  
mooring buoys so your boat  
shall be safely tied off without  
damaging corals or any  
surrounding marine life.



## Keep Their Home Clean

Don't litter.  
Dispose of your waste  
properly, and recycle  
whenever possible.
